To all whom it may concern, be it known that I Nelson Nichols of Anne Arundel County in the state of Maryland, for divers good causes and considerations me thereunto moving, as also in further consideration of five dollars lawful money to me in hand paid have released from slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free, and by these presents do hereby release from slavery, liberate, manumit and set free my negro boy named Samuel Garrett being of the age of sixteen years, and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance, and him the said negro boy named Samuel Garrett I do declare to be free, manumitted and discharged from and after the first day of January one thousand eight hundred and forty eight, from and after which time aforesaid from all manner of servitude or service to me, my
