 money to me in hand paid have released from
 slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free, and
 by these presents do hereby release from slavery,
 manumit, liberate and set free the following
 negroes, to wit: my negro woman Sarah Whitaker
 aged twenty five years, to be free at the age of thirty
 four years, that is to say, nine years from the date
 hereof, and the said Sarah Whitaker's child Robert
 aged ten months to be free when he arrives to the
 age of twenty eight years, and the said negro woman
 and her child I do declare to be free, manumitted
 and discharged from all manner of service or
 servitude to me my executors or administrators
 forever, on the above conditions above described.
 In witness whereof, I have set my hand and seal
 this 25. day of October Eighteen hundred and thirty
 four, the word 'eight' interlined before signing.
