

To all whom it may concern, be it known, that I Mary Galloway Macey of the City of Washington, in the District of Columbia for divers good causes and considerations me therunto moving, have released from slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby release from slavery, liberate, manumit and set free my Mulatto girl named Jane, being of the age of ten years, and her the said Mulatto girl named Jane I do declare to be henceforth free, manumitted and discharged from all manner of servitude or service to me, my executors or administrators forever.

In testimony whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this sixth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty four.
