 M Lane Brown of Anne Arundel County in the State of  
 Maryland for divers good causes and Considerations me  
 thereunto moving have released from Slavery liberated and  
 set free and by these presents do hereby release from Slavery  
 liberate Manumit and set free my negro Girl named Looe  
 aged sixteen years on the third day of March next to be free  
 when she shall arrive at the age of forty years that is to say  
 to be free and at full Liberty and discharged from all manner  
 of servitude on the third day of March one thousand eight  
 hundred and Sixty, and all her issue to be free at the age  
 of thirty five years from me my heirs executors administrators  
 and assigns In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my  
 hand and affixed my seal the third day of August one  
 thousand eight hundred and thirty five
