 said bill of sale said bargain sell transfer and assign
 both the said Negro Girl slaves named Ellen and
 Harriet unto the said Alexander Stambull his
 Executors administrators and assigns each for the
 term of thirty five years from the tenth day of
 September eight hundred and twenty five
 and from the tenth day of February eight
 hundred and twenty seven respectively which
 said respective terms will expire cease and determine
 on the foresaid tenth day of September eight
 hundred and sixty and the tenth day of February
 eight hundred and sixty two and the said Negro
 girls slaves named Ellen and Harriet I do declare
 to be thenceforth that is to say the said Ellen from
 and after the tenth day of September eight
 hundred and sixty and the said Harriet from
 and after the tenth day of February eight hundred
 and sixty two freed manumitted and discharged
 from all manner of servitude or service to me my
 Executors or administrators and from all manner
 of claim or right of claim of servitude or service by me
 my Executors or administrators forever. And I do
 hereby also release from slavery liberate manumit
 and set free the issue that may be born of the
 said Negro Girl slave named Ellen on or before the
 tenth day of September eight hundred and
