personally appeared Rose Thomas free woman of colour  
before me the Subscriber a Justice of the peace in and  
for Anne Arundel County and acknowledged the within  
deed of manumission to be her act and deed and the  
Mulatto woman therein named Charity to be henceforth  
manumitted freed & discharged from all kind of slavery  
in as full and ample a manner as if she had never been  
a slave according to the purpose true intent and  
meaning of said deed of manumission and the acts  
of assembly in such case made & provided  
Acknowledged before Edward Dubois  
Recorded the 15<sup>th</sup> day of January 1836.
