 liberated manumitted and set free, and by then
 presents do hereby, release from Slavery manumitted and
 set free my Negro man named Samuel Leggett being
 of the age of fifty five and able to work and give
 a sufficient livelihood and maintenance and him
 the said Negro man named Samuel I do declare
 to be at the expiration of my death to be manumitted
 and discharged from all manner of servitude or
 service to my Executors administrators or assigns
 forever In Testimony whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand and affixed my seal this ninth day
 of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and thirty six
