 have released from Slavery liberated manumitted
 and set free and by these presents do hereby release
 from Slavery liberated manumitted and set free my Negro
 man named William Brown being of the age of
 forty four years and able to work and gain a sufficient
 livelihood and maintenance with him the said Negro
 man named William Brown I do declare to be hence forth
 free manumitted and discharged from all claims of,
 servitude or claims to me my Executors or administrators
 for ever In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and affixed my seal this eighth day of April in
 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 and thirty nine
