Whereas by my deed of purchase made dated on or
about the 10th day of April in the year eighteen hundred
and thirty six and duly acknowledged and recorded
I did amongst other things manumit and set free my
negro boy named Charles commonly called Charles
Franklin told free on and after the first day of May
in the year eighteen hundred and fifty seven. And
whereas for various good considerations I have resolved
to confer immediate freedom on said boy now known
all men by these presents that for and in consideration
of the premises aforesaid I have manumitted and set
free and by these presents do manumit and set free
from slavery my aforesaid Negro boy Charles and
release and discharge him from all servitude to
me my executors administrators and assigns for
ever In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this 10th day of June 1839
