

Act of assembly in such cases made and provided
 at Newburgh before Joseph Daniels
 Justice of the peace
 Recorded the 21 day of June 1839

To all whom it may concern Be it known That I
 Job Guest of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland
 for more good causes and considerations and therein to
 appearing do from and after the first day of January Eighteen
 hundred and fifty two release from all claims and demands
 against and set free and by these presents do hereby
 release from slavery at and after the period above
 named, a male and set free my negro boy named
 Sarah, being now about fifteen years of age and at
 that time sound in body and able to work and give
 a sufficient maintenance, and at which time namely
 on the first of January Eighteen hundred and fifty two
 he will be about twenty seven years of age and then
 the said negro boy named Sarah I do declare from
 the above named period to be emancipated and
 discharged from all manner of service or servitude
 to me my executors or administrators or to any other
 person claiming under me or for me. In Testimony whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this
 Eighth day of January in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and fifty
