 legally authorized as usual and did read and appeared to the
 foregoing Instrument affecting as fully to the same and
 advised me saying to his fully understood and approved the same
 Instrument affecting as his act and deed for the purposes
 therein contained and as he said and that he was
 then and there called to mind and lawfully known by the
 name of Anne Henry to be his lawful owner and
 absolutely liberated and discharged from slavery and
 all servitude as to him his Executors Administrators
 or to any other person claiming under him and that he
 has forth and forever free and unincumbered and unincumbered
 according to the act of assembly in such respects and
 as he said. Attest my hand and seal of office this
 fourth day of November 1837.
