 and Priscilla Bell viz Sam aged eighteen, George
 aged sixteen, Richard aged fourteen, John aged
 twelve, Trudy aged ten years, Mary Ann aged
 seven years, James aged five and Sarah aged
 three years Immanuel and wife, the males when
 they shall have arrived at the age of twenty years
 and the females when they shall have respectively attained
 the age of twenty years. The children of Sophia
 Taylor viz Henry or Henrietta aged fifteen, Samuel
 aged twelve, Grafton aged five, Sophia ten years
 Elizabeth aged three years and Betty aged one year
