Know all men by these presents that I Perry Jacobs
 of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for divers
 good causes and lawful intentions with intent moving hand
 from me upon the first day of January in the year of our
 Lord Eighteen hundred and forty two did and did not before
 released from slavery unmanumitted liberated and set free
 and by these presents do give and upon the said day and
 not before release from slavery unmanumitted liberated and
 set free my Negro boy named David being at present of
 about the age of four months and ten thousand seven hundred
 and eighty seven dollars and the said first day of January
 Eighteen hundred and forty two did and do for ever thereafter
 give unmanumitted liberated and discharged from
 all manner of service and obedience to me my executors
 administrators and assigns In Witness whereof I
 have to set my hand and seal this 29th day of January
 Eighteen hundred and forty two
