 I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
 this twenty fourth day of February in the year of our
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and Eighteen.

 named to be henceforth manumitted and discharged
 from all services to him or to any claiming under
 him and to be free and manumitted according to the
 act of Parliament in such case made and provided.
