 declare the said Negro Slave to be liberated and free from
 all and every former and to come any and every such, and from
 all and every person or persons whatsoever provided that the said
 arrival at the morning of the presents and of the
 parties hereto that if the said Negro Slave shall refuse to accept
 the offer of freedom herein contained and shall refuse to
 emigrate to Liberia or such other place on the Coast of Africa
 as may be proposed to him by the Board of Managers and
 within the time to be limited by the said Board of Managers
 that these presents in every thing therein contained designed
 to favour the freedom of the said Negro Slave shall be utterly
 null and void and the said Slave on such refusal shall
 be and remain the property of the undersigned representatives
 of the said steamer and it is also hereby further expressed and
 declared that upon the capture of the slaves herein proposed
 by the said Negro it is that the said Stephen Beard witness
 shall be as aforesaid is hereby authorized and empowered to
 deliver the said Slave to the Managers aforesaid and to do
 hereby release acquit & exonerate and discharge the said
 administrator from all claims or demands by or from or any
 on either of us and our heirs or assigns of such delivery
 In Witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals
 this eleventh day of April in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and forty three
