

This Deed of manumission made and executed this seventh day of March in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and Eighteen by David Robinson of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland - Witnesseth that for divers good causes and considerations sheweth money as well as for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars current money of the United States to me in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and himself pleased to be satisfied contented and paid dole by these presents manumitted liberated and set free and hereby forever discharged from all further service to me or my heirs after the expiration of the terms herein mentioned that is to say my negro woman Priscilla to be free and discharged from and after the first day of January in the year of our Lord Eighteen and twenty five and that her increase be free at the age of thirty years; also that my negro boy Harris aged about three years shall be hereby free forever discharged from me or my heirs after the first day of Jan<sup>y</sup> in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and forty five. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the day and year first within written.
