 I Charles Carroll of Carrollton of the County
 of Prince Georges in the State of Maryland, for divers good causes
 and considerations and therein moving as also for
 the further consideration of five dollars current money
 to me in hand paid, have released from slavery
 liberated manumitted and set free, and by these
 presents do hereby release from slavery, liberate
 manumitted and set free my negro woman named
 Elizabeth being of the age of eighteen years and able
 to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and
 maintenance, and her the said negro woman
 named Elizabeth I do declare to be henceforth free
 manumitted and discharged from all manner of
 servitude or service to me my Executors or administrators
 forever. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand and affixed my seal this 26th day of May
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and eighteen.
