To all whom it may concern Be it known that I am Master of Anne Anne County in the State of Maryland for diverse good causes and considerations mentioned moving as also in further consideration of forty dollars current money to me in hand paid have released from slavery liberated manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby release from from slavery liberate manumitted and set free my mulatto woman named Fanny being of the age of thirty seven years and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance and her the said mulatto woman named Fanny I do declare to be henceforth free manumitted and discharged from all manner of servitude to me
