To all whom it may concern Be it known
 that I Mary Isaac of Anne Arundel County in
 Maryland for divers good causes & considerations and
 thoughts moving have released from Slavery liberated
 manumitted and set free; and by these presents
 do release from Slavery liberate manumitted & set free
 the following named negroes from and after the
 period that they respectively shall arrive to exactly
 five years of age viz Liley born 15th April 1788 to
 be free from and after the date hereof, Lydia
 born 6th December 1801, Henry born 15th March
 1806, George born 15th September 1807, Clarissa
 born 15th April 1809, Daniel born 20th March 1810,
 Charles born 10th December 1812, Caroline born 5th
 April 1816, Robert born 12th June 1818. and I do
 hereby declare each of the above named
 negroes to be free from and after the day that
 each may respectively accomplish their twenty
