in Maryland for divers good causes & considerations
me therein moving, have released from Slavery
manumitted and set free and by these presents
do release from Slavery liberate manumit & set
free the following named Negroes from and
after the period that they respectively shall
arrive to twenty five years of age Viz Dinah
born 7th Nov^r 1795. Daniel born 14th July 1809
William born 21st March 1812. Benjamin born
19th Aug^t 1814 and Mary Ann born 27th May 1818
and I do hereby declare each of the aforesaid
