 of the servitude of the said Melly she shall have
 any issue of her body begotten then I do determine
 grant and agree the State or Condition of the said
 issue shall be free the males at the age of twenty
 five years and the females at the age of twenty one
 years and I do hereby manumit and set free the
 said issue at the said ages In Witness whereof I
 the said Samuel Jones have hereunto set my
 hand and affixed my seal this Eleventh day of
 January Eighteen hundred and nineteen.

 in such cases made and provided.
