Eliza (Elizas Daughter) aged about twelve years to be free on the twenty fifth day of December one thousand eight hundred and thirty four. Charlotte aged about eleven years old and Sarah aged about ten (Susans Daughters) Charlotte to be free the twenty fifth day of December one thousand eight hundred and thirty five. Sarah to be free the twenty fifth day of December one thousand eight hundred and thirty six. and I do discharge them from all servitude and forever quit claim to all right and title to them on the days and years aforesaid from me my heirs Executors and administrators forever In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 15th day of January one thousand eight hundred and thirty six.
