

To all whom it may concern. Be it known that I Alexander Randall of the city of Annapolis in the state of Maryland for and in consideration of one hundred and twelve dollars current money and for and in consideration of divine good causes and considerations me thereto moving, have released from slavery, liberated manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby release from slavery liberate and set free my metello woman Eliza called Eliza Paul being about the age of twenty seven years and able to gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance, and her the said negre Eliza Paul I do declare to be henceforth free manumitted and discharged from all manner of service or servitude to me my executors or administrators forever. In witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and fix my seal this twenty seventh day of December in the year eighteen hundred and fifty four.

desirous now of purchasing her freedom and is willing to give therefor
the sum of five hundred dollars, Now therefore I Richard L. Black Rubin
of Anne Arundel County in the state of Maryland for and in
consideration of the above and of the sum of five hundred dollars
current money to me in hand well and truly paid by the said
