 Commence from the date of these presents the said Nancy
 being the same person heretofore manumitted by me to
 be free on the twenty fourth day of January eighteen
 hundred and sixty two by deed of manumission bearing
 date the twenty fourth day of January eighteen
 hundred and fifty four duly executed & acknowledged
 recorded in Liber D. N. 4 folio 85. one of the
 Manumission and books of Anne Arundel County

Witness my hand and seal the sixteenth day of
 May eighteen hundred and fifty nine
 Test J. C. Gessaway Wm Glover (Seal)

at the foot of the aforesaid was then and there
 State of Maryland City of Annapolis & County
 of Prince Georges the sixteenth day of May in the year
 eighteen hundred & fifty nine before the Subscribes
 a Justice of the Peace of the State of Maryland
 in and for Anne Arundel County personally appeared
 William Brewer the party granted in the foregoing
 and acknowledged the same to which act
 Recorded the 16 day of May 1859

To all whom it may concern Be it known
 that I John D. Scott of Anne Arundel County
 in the State of Maryland for divers good causes
 and considerations me thereto moving have
 released from slavery liberated manumitted
 and set free and by these presents do hereby release
