 fifth day of October which will be in the year of our
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty one one
 mulatto man slave belonging to me and owned in
 my possession by the name of Charles Foltz a boy
 whatever name he may be called a known
 being at that time of the age of eleven years seven
 months and the said mulatto man slave named
 Charles Foltz, I do declare to be the same fact that
 is to say from and after the said fifth day of
 October one thousand eight hundred and fifty one
 manumitted and discharged from all manner of
 servitude or service to me my executor or administrator
 and from all manner of claim or right of claim of
 servitude or service by me my executor or administrator
 forever In Testimony whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand and affixed my seal this fourteenth
 day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and thirty three
 Signed Sealed & delivered in
 presence of us.
