I Haysel Hayses of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland do hereby Manumit and Set free my neeps Slaves of Adeline Hayses now Allen aged about twenty seven years her freedom to Commence from the date of these presents; and Rachel Ann Allen now aged about four years and William Francis Allen aged two years the freedom of the last named to Commence when they shall respectively attain the age of eighteen years and the said last named, Rachel Ann and W^m Francis being the Children of Adeline Hayses now Allen conveyed to the said Haysel Hayses by Benjamin Clarke by Bill of Sale dated September 1st 1841 and recorded in Liber.
