This Indenture made the first day of May in the year four
 Lord and thousand eight hundred and Sixty. Witnesseth that
 J. Matthias Luthicum being prompted by motives of charity
 and benevolence do Manumit liberate and set free my
 Negro Slave Henderson Warren aged some 22 years of good
 Moral Character, and by these presents do release and deliver
 Said Slave from all Manner of Servitude, My heirs or assigns
 forever In Witness whereof I hereunto affix my hand & Seal
 this first day of May in the year above written
 Signed Sealed & delivered

 certify that on the 17 day of May 1860 personally appeared
 before the Subscriber a Justice of the peace of the State of

Know all men by these presents that I
 Robert Franklyn of Anne Arundel County in the
 State of Maryland for divers good Causes me
 thereunto moving do hereby release from Slavery
 Manumit liberate and set free my negro man John
 Anderson aged about thirty three years a Slave of the
 able to gain a livelihood and support and labour
 the said John Anderson's freedom to commence on
 and after the first day of January eight thousand
 and sixty eight, and I do hereby declare him to be
 free and discharged from all Manner of Servitude
 to me my executors and administrators forever
