Slavery liberate Manumitted and set free My negro woman
Eliza Sparrow being about thirty one year of age
together with her Child Mary Eliza Sparrow about
one year old also My negro woman Rachel Jennings
about thirty five years of age, and her two Sons James
Smith, and John Smith aged respectively fourteen
thirteen years, and them the said Negroes I do
declare to be henceforth free Manumitted and
discharged from all manner of service or servitude
to me my Executors or Administrators forever

On this 28 day of May 1869 personally appeared
