 eight hundred and ninety one, and all her issue if
 any to be free at the age of thirty five Sound and healthy
 and the said Abraham Keell and Keurilla Johnson
 I do declare to be from the above stated periods free
 Manumitted and discharged from all manner of
 servitude or service for me my Executor or administration
 In Witness whereof I have unto Subscribed my name and
 affixed my Seal the twenty fourth day of May eight
 hundred and eighty Wm Shipley (Seal)
