 charged from all manner of service or service to me
 to me my executors or administrators forever. I
 also manumit and set free Dolly Johnson aged
 fourteen years to be free on the first day of January
 eighteen hundred and forty nine and clear after release
 her from all manner of service or service to me
 my executors or administrators forever.
