"Whereas my slave Elias Hamilton has
enlisted in the Service of the United States, now in
consideration thereof I Basil Benson of Anne Arundel
County State of Maryland do hereby in consideration
of said enlistment manumit let free and release
the above named Elias Hamilton from all Service
due me by said enlistment from the 17 day of
March 1864 the date of his said enlistment as
aforesaid in the 10th Regiment of Colored Troops
in the Service of the United States,
