Whereas my Slave William Brown has enlisted in the service of the United States, now in consideration thereof I Mary Mullan of Anne Arundel County State of Maryland do hereby in consideration of said enlistment Manumit & free and release the above named William Brown from all service due me her freedom to commence from the third day of March 1864 the date of his enlistment as aforesaid in the 36th Regiment of Colored Troops in the service of the United States,

Whereas my Slave Robert Heyd has enlisted in the service of the United States, now in consideration thereof I John E Heyd of Anne Arundel County State of Maryland do hereby in consideration of said enlistment & free and release the above named Robert Heyd from all service due me her freedom to commence from the 1st day of June 1864 the date of his enlistment as aforesaid in the
