Whereas my Slave William Bell has enlisted  
 in the Service of the United States, Now in Consideration  
 thereof I George Wells of Anne Arundel County State  
 of Maryland do hereby in Consideration of said  
 enlistment Manumit & free and release the above  
 named William Bell from all Service due me: his  
 Service to commence from the 23 day of February  
 1814 the date of his enlistment as of record in the  
 30<sup>th</sup> Regiment of Colonial Troops in the Service  
 of the United States
