 in the service of the United States, & now in consideration thereof
 I James C. Williams of Prince Georges County State of
 Maryland do hereby in consideration of said enlistment
 manumit set free and release the above named Stephen W.
 Boone from all service and service her freedom to commence
 from the 21 day of May 1864 the date of his enlistment
 as aforesaid in the 39 Regiment of Colored Troops in the
 service of the United States. Witness my hand and seal
 this 30th day of April 1864
