Slavery manumitted and set free my

other necessaries of life to wit I have let  
aged thirty five years Julia and Ruth  
aged three years two in daughters of the  
above named Charlott to serve their mother  
until they arrive at the age of sixteen years  
Nas the Lane aged thirty years Ruth aged  
twenty eight years Richard aged six years  
Parsilla aged four years and Charles aged two  
months children of the above named Ruth  
to serve their mother the males until they  
arrive at the age of twenty one years and
