Whereas my slave Richard James has enlisted in the service of the United States, then in consideration thereof I Elizabeth Randall of Anne Arundel County State of Maryland do hereby do Cause doleat of said aforesaid Manumission and Release the above named Richard James from all Service and her person to commence from the 31st day of March last the date of her enlistment, as aforesaid in the 39th Regiment of Colored Troops, in the service of the United States, My hand and Seal this 30th day of June 1864
