Deed of Manumission and Release of Service

Whereas my slave Frederick Parker has enlisted with the service of the United States, now in consideration thereof I Jacob Bacey of Anne Arundel County State of Maryland do hereby in consideration of said enlistment Manumit & Release the above named Frederick Parker from all Service due and to be rendered to me commencing from the 31 day of March the date of his enlistment as aforesaid in the 39 Regiment of Colored Troops in the service of the United States, Witness my hand and Seal this 12 day of June 1864
