Maryland do hereby in Consideration of said settlement
Manumit & I have and release the above named William
Fowler from all Service due me by said man to commence
from the 25 February 1864 the date of her intestment
as aforesaid in the 3rd Regiment of Colored Troops,
in the service of the United States,
