To all whom it may Concern Be it known that
I Rachel A. Luck widow of Washington Luck
deceased of Anne Arundel County in the State of
Maryland for divers good Causes and Considerations
my thereto moving have released from Slavery
liberated Manumitted and set free and by these
presents do hereby release from Slavery liberate
Manumitted and set free my Negro man named
Lewis Samson being of the age of Forty one years
and able to work and give a sufficient livelihood
and maintenance and him the said Negro man
Lewis Samson I do declare to be henceforth
set Manumitted and discharged from all manner
of Service or Service due him my Executor or
administration forever In Witness whereof I have
