

Deed Manumission
from Dorsey Jacob
To
Slave Hezekiah

Know all Men by these pres-
ents, that J. Dorsey Jacob in
the State of Maryland for
divers good causes and Consi-
derations, me thereunto mov-

ing, have from and upon the ninth day of February,
eighteen hundred and seventy four, and not
before, released from Slavery, Manumitted, liberated
and set free, and by these presents do, from and
upon the said day and not before, release from sla-
very, manumit, liberate and set free my negro
boy named Hezekiah, being at present of about
the age of seven months, and him the said Heze-
kiah, I hereby declare to be from the said ninth
day of February, eighteen hundred and seventy
four, and forever thenceforth, freed Manumitt-
ed, liberated and discharged from all manner
of service and servitude to me, my executors
administrators and assigns.

In witness whereof, I, hereunto set my hand
and seal this 27th day of August Eighteen hun-
dred, and forty six.
