

Whereas my slave David Ireland has enlisted in the service of the United States, now in consideration thereof I James Owens of Anne Arundel County State of Maryland do hereby in consideration of said enlistment manumit, set free, and release the above named David Ireland from all service due me his freedom to commence from the 21st March 1864 the date of his enlistment as aforesaid in the 30th Regiment of Colored Troops in the service of the United States.
