Deed of Manumission and Release of Service  
Whereas my slave George Kelly has enlisted in the service of the United States now in consideration thereof I Stephen Lark of Anne Arundel County State of Maryland do hereby in consideration of said enlistment manumit and set free and release the above named George Kelly from all service due me his freedom to commence from the 31<sup>st</sup> day of March 1864 the date of his enlistment as aforesaid in the thirty ninth Regiment of Colored Troops in the service of the United States
