Deed of Manumission  
 from Rezin H. Snowden  
 to  
 Sundry Negroes

To all whom it may concern  
 be it known that of Rezin  
 H. Snowden of Anne Arun-  
 del, County in the State  
 of Maryland for diverse good

causes and considerations me thereunto moving  
 have released from Slavery liberated manumitted  
 and set free the following negroes to wit Eliza aged  
 forty one years Look aged thirty seven years Margaret  
 aged thirteen years and Martha aged nine years  
 each to serve their mother the above named Look  
 until they arrive at the age of sixteen years Matilda  
 aged seventeen years Milly aged twenty two years Eliza  
 Jane aged seven years to serve her mother the above  
 mentioned Milly until she arrives at the age of  
 sixteen years Delia aged twenty years and her  
 daughter Susann aged three years to serve her mother  
 the above mentioned Delia until she arrives at  
 the age of sixteen years being able to work and gain
