 of them hereafter mentioned that is to say Tom
 aged Twenty years and William aged twenty
 years each to be free on the first day of January
 Eighteen hundred and fifty two John aged nine
 teen years to be free on the first day of January
 Eighteen hundred and fifty three Samuel aged
 sixteen years to be free on the first day of January
 Eighteen hundred and fifty six Joseph aged
 fifteen years to be free on the first day of January

 aged thirteen years to be free on the first day of

 Lambert aged Twelve years to be free on the
