by these presents
that G. George Weems
of Anne Arundel County
in the State of Maryland

and, for divers good causes and considerations
me thereunto moving, have from and after
the periods herein after mentioned, liber-
ated, and set free, and by these presents
do after such periods, liberate, manumit and
from Slavery and servitude discharge and
set free, my two negro boys namely John and
Thomas, children of my negro woman slave
Caroline, the said John to be free on the first
day of August Eighteen hundred and sixty
