Deed of Manumission
 from Henry Maynader
 to
 Joseph Parker

This Indenture
 witnesseth that
 J. Henry Maynad-
 -ier, of Anne Arund-
 -el, County, in the

State of Maryland, for and in consideration
 of the sum of $\$$ Ten cents to me in hand paid
 at and before the enrolling and delivery
 of these presents, the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged, have released from
 Slavery manumitted and set free, and by
 these presents do release from Slavery man-
 -umit, and set free, my Negro man named
 Joseph Parker, being under forty five years
 of age, of a healthy constitution, sound in
 mind and Body, and capable by labor to
 procure to him sufficient food and raiment
 with other requisite necessaries of life —
