Deed of Manumission
from Henry May-
nardier, to
Elisha Parker

This Indenture
witnesseth that
J. Henry Maynardier
of Anne Arundel
County in the State
of Maryland, for

and in consideration of the sum of ten cents
to me in hand paid, at and before the
ensealing and delivery of these presents, the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have
released from Slavery, manumitted and set
free, and by these presents do release from
Slavery, manumit and set free, my Negro
man named Elisha Parker, being under
forty five years of age, of a healthy constitution
sound in mind and Body, and capable by
labor to procure to him sufficient food and
raiment, with the other requisit necessaries
