William Lomax

Ellen Lomax

know all men by
these presents, that I
William Lomax of
Anne Arundel County,
in the State of Maryland

for divers good causes and considerations me
thereunto moving, and of the sum of one
dollar, to me in hand paid, have released
from slavery, liberated, manumitted and
set free, and by these presents do release from
slavery, liberate, manumit and set free, my
slave woman named Ellen Lomax, being
of the age of thirty years, and able to work,
and gain a sufficient livelihood and
maintenance, and her the said slave
woman named Ellen Lomax, I do declare
to be henceforth free, manumitted and
discharged from all manner of service, a
servitude to me, my executors and
Administrators forever. In Testimony whereof,
I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
my seal, this 19th day of April 1848
