Deed of Manumission from
James Legg
to
Amelia Stewart

To all whom it may
concern, be it known,
that I, James Legg of the
City of Annapolis, State of
Maryland, for divers

good causes and considerations me therunto
moving, as also in further consideration of five
dollars, current money to me in hand paid,
have released from slavery, liberated, manumit-
ted and set free, and by these presents do hereby
release from slavery, liberate, manumit and
set free, my negro woman named Amelia
Stewart, being of the age of twenty five years, and
able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood, and
maintenance, and her the said negro woman,
named Amelia Stewart, I do declare to be hereafter
free, manumitted and discharged from all
manner of servitude, or service, to me, my
Executors or Administrators forever. In testimony
whereof, I have herewith set my hand, and
affixed my seal this 18th day of November,
eighteen hundred and forty eight
