To all whom it may concern be it known that I Richard W Gill of the City of Annapolis in Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for divers good causes and Considerations me thereto moving have released from Slavery liberated Manumitted and Set Free and by these presents do hereby release from Slavery liberate Manumit and Set free my negro girl named Cornelia Sims being of the age of seventeen years and able to work and give a sufficient livelihood and maintenance and her the said negro girl named Cornelia Sims I do declare to be henceforth free Manumitted and discharged from all manner of Service or Servitude to me my Executors or administrators forever In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal on this twenty Sixth day of November in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and fifty one
